

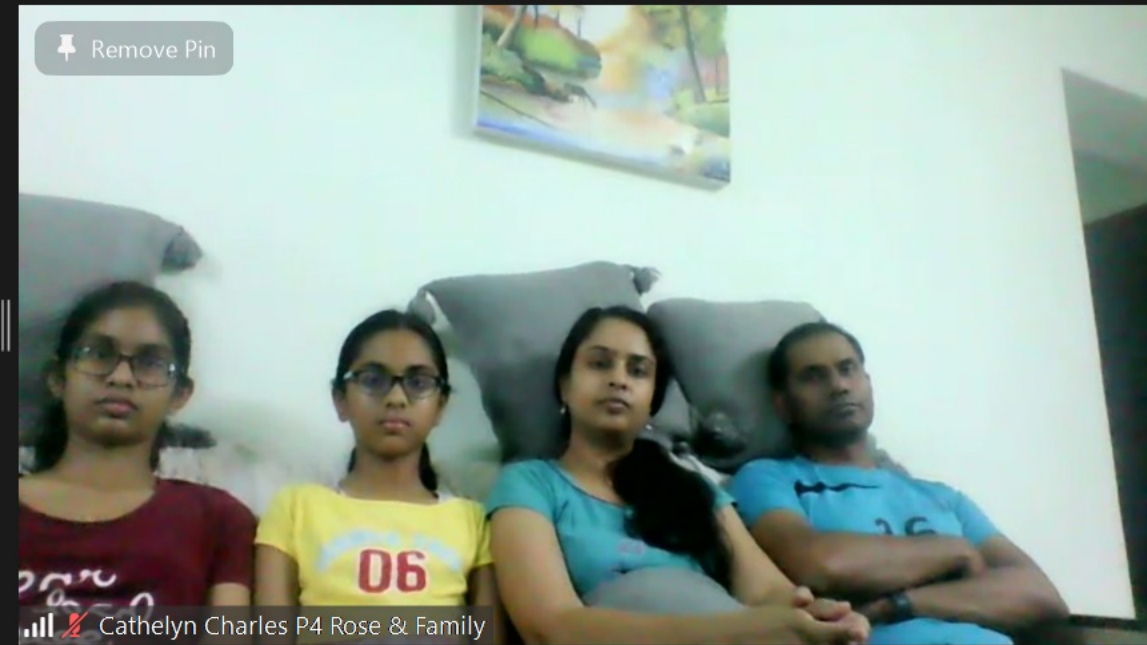

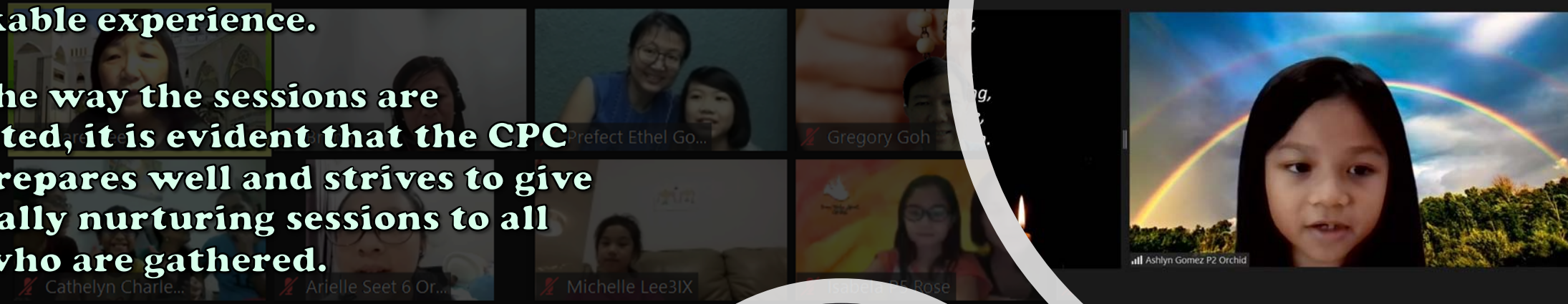
Participating in the past one year of these prayer sessions has been a remarkable experience.

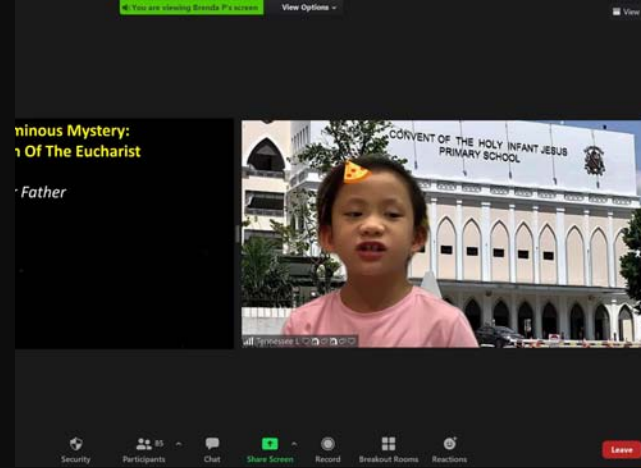
From the way the sessions are conducted, it is evident that the CPC team prepares well and strives to give spiritually nurturing sessions to all those who are gathered.

I am also impressed by Dr Lee's lovely interactions with the girls before and during the sessions, which are quite comforting and very thoughtful of her.

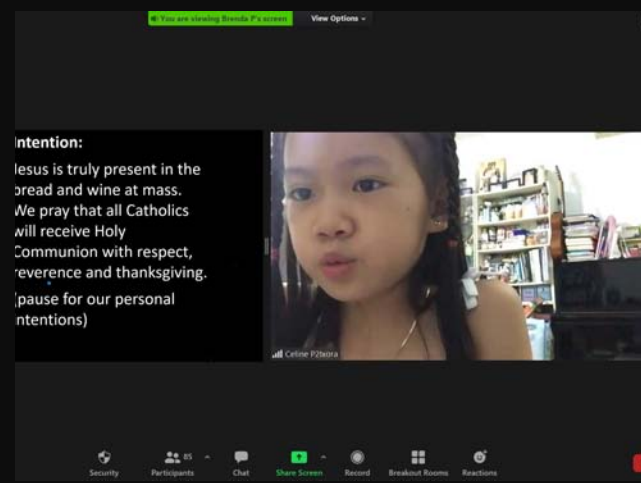
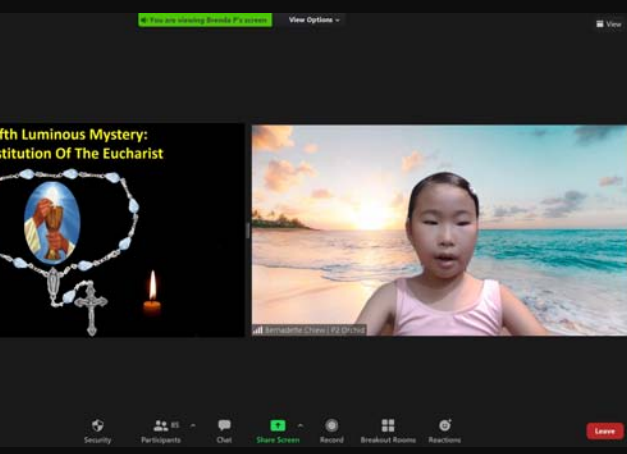

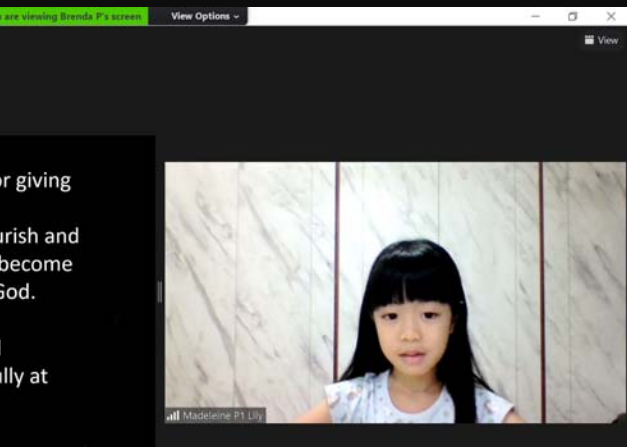
Over time, it has been heartening to see the sessions introduce elements such as...
