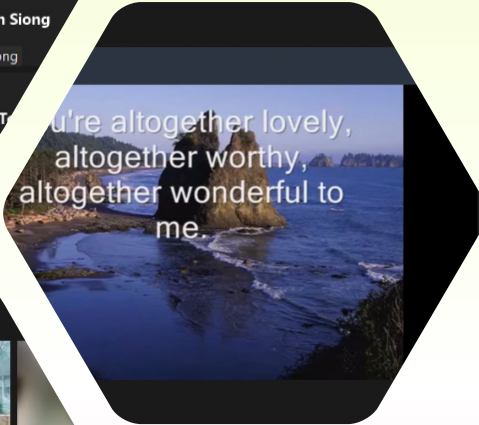
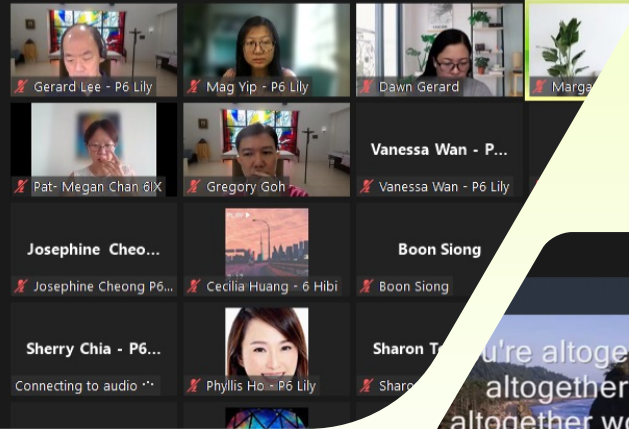
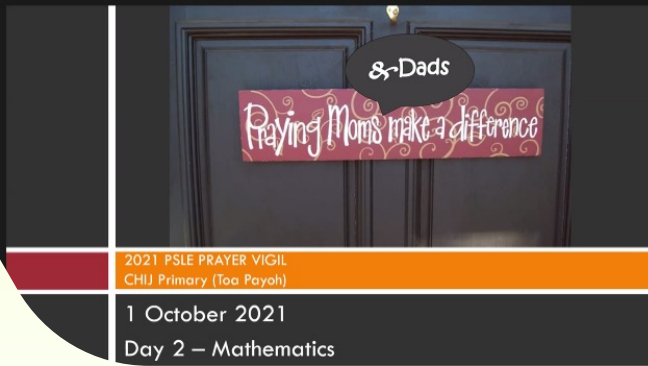
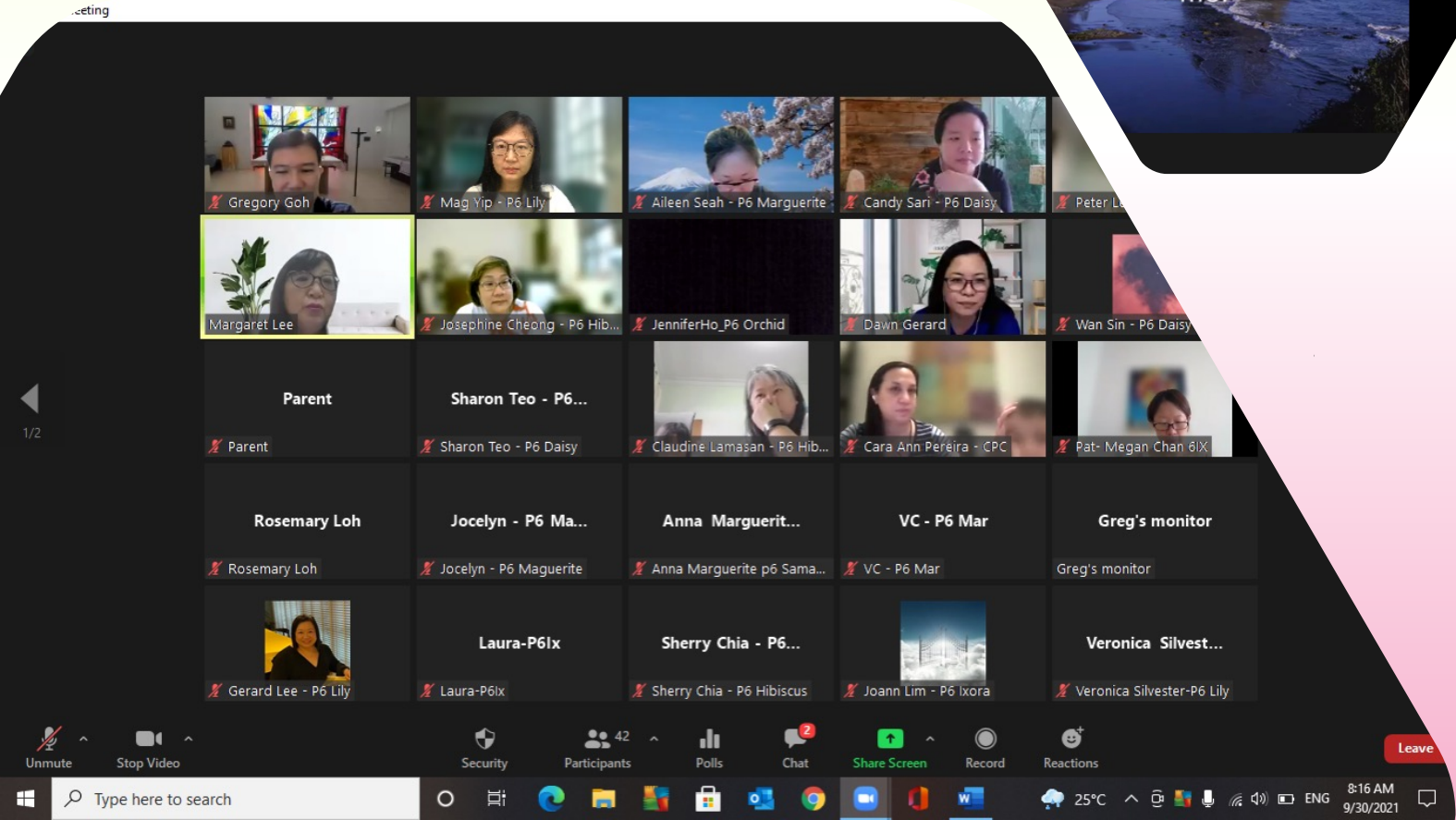


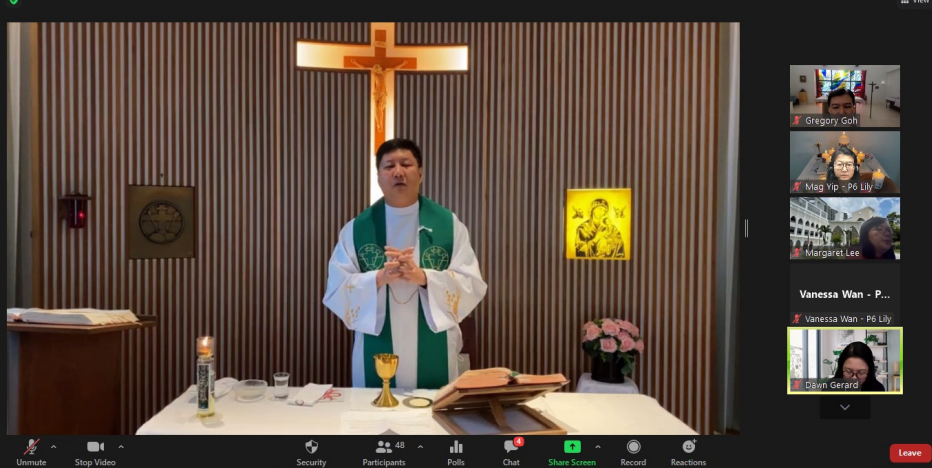
PSLE VIGIL 2021
